2. Student Registration

2.1 Online Registration of Incoming Naresuan University Students via NU's Online Registration System

Qualified students who have confirmed their admission may proceed with online registration by filling out the student registration form at:

<https://www.admission.nu.ac.th/registar> from 15-20 June 2026 (If there are any changes, you will be informed later). Please follow the steps below:

2.1.1 Complete the registration form accurately and in full.

2.1.2 Upload a formal, half-body self-portrait in JPEG format (.jpg).

- Required dimensions: 1 inch, resolution not less than 300 x 400 pixels, 300 dpi
- Maximum file size: 2 MB

2.1.3 Upload a copy of your educational qualification or degree certificate in PDF format (.pdf).

- Ensure the scanned file is complete, clear, and legible.

2.1.4 Upload a copy of your original transcript of records indicating course completion in PDF format (.pdf).

- Ensure the document is complete, clear, and legible.

2.1.5 Once the registration form is completed and all documents are uploaded, the student will receive a Student User Account and Student Email Account. These credentials grant access to various Naresuan University online systems, including the Registration System (REG), university email, Wi-Fi, and the online learning platform.

Note: Students who fail to complete the online registration process within the specified timeframe will forfeit their right to admission at Naresuan University.

Important Notice: Document Verification for Online Registration

All documents uploaded to the online registration system will be thoroughly reviewed and verified for accuracy by the Student Registration and Processing Section, Division of Academic Affairs, Naresuan University.

If any documents are found to be inaccurate or incomplete, students will be required to appear in person with the original documents at the Student Registration and Processing Section, QS Building, Naresuan University. Please make sure to bring the original documents for verification. (The document verification schedule will be announced later.)

Failure to comply will result in incomplete registration and may lead to termination of student status, in accordance with university regulations.

If any submitted documents are found to contain false or forged information, the university reserves the right to immediately disqualify the student's admission.

2.2 Courses and schedule of classes may be checked online at the university's online registration system website (www.reg.nu.ac.th) from 20 June 2026 onwards. Naresuan University shall continue the enrollment in the first semester.

All incoming students are required to complete the registration process by themselves. Study the registration process at www.reg.nu.ac.th
